Recognized as a public utility organization for international solidarity, the association works to enhance the self-sufficiency of communities by providing access to water and imparting knowledge about the significance of daily hygiene.

LET'S STAND TOGETHER IN SOLIDARITY

In a France affected by increased poverty post-Covid, the JVD teams have implemented initiatives or made donations of useful products such as :

- A donation of hygiene and hospitality accessories to the LAZARE association to equip its solidarity shared housing between homeless people and young professionals in the houses of Nantes, Rennes, and recently Marseille.
- A donation of 200 disinfection stations to support the activities of the ADMR association which provides personal services for autonomy, home comfort, and overall health.
- The purchase of coffee machines from Café Joyeux, a social enterprise that employs and trains individuals primarily with Down syndrome or cognitive disorders such as autism.



SUPPORT FOR THE SOCIAL AND SOLIDARITY ECONOMY

SUBCONTRACTING IN A CORRECTIONAL ENVIRONMENT

For over 10 years, JVD has been collaborating with Façon Ouest. Through industrial subcontracting in correctional facilities, companies benefit from a skilled workforce while providing inmates with an opportunity for professional reintegration upon their release from prison.



Concerned about our social impact, we rely on social and solidarity economy associations. For instance, the Dust Bag that accompanies your Shield Compact is handmade and sewn by a Sheltered Employment Center (ESAT) employing individuals with disabilities.

In 2023, JVD donated a batch of 18 former industrial workstations to ESATCO44 to give them a second life. As a true player in the Social and Solidarity Economy, ESATCO44 employs over 1,800 professionals, including 1,350 individuals with disabilities, to enhance the skills of each individual.



PARTNERSHIP WITH BPI FRANCE

JVD is thrilled to join **the Coq Vert community**. We are now part of a collective of businesses committed to addressing energy and environmental challenges! Launched in partnership with **ADEME (French Environment and Energy Management Agency) and the Ministry of Ecological Transition**, the Coq Vert community aims to create a collective drive towards ecological transition, leading to medium-term eco-responsible actions such as optimizing our energy consumption and reducing our carbon footprint and greenhouse gas emissions (GHG).

INITIATIVES THAT WERE CLOSE TO OUR HEARTS

In 2020, amidst a France impacted by increased poverty following the Covid-19 pandemic, it is crucial that food distribution remains unaffected by health risks. In this regard, the JVD teams have made available :

- 500 disinfection stations to equip the reception centers of Les Restos du Cœur throughout France.
- 200 disinfection stations have been donated additionally to the EMMAÜS Solidarité association to equip its premises, sales areas, and emergency reception and accommodation spaces.



ACT FOR OUR PLANET PROJECT

The CSR commitment of JVD is a collective commitment. That is why, with the participation of each employee, we have created the Act for our Planet project. The objective is to generate ideas for actions to be implemented by the company to reduce its carbon footprint.

Commenced in 2020, this internal initiative has sparked numerous positive changes in our daily lives (such as the use of reusable cups and bottles as alternatives to disposable products, the purchase of electric bicycles, the installation of electric vehicle charging stations, etc.).



SUPPORT FOR THE PROVIDENTI'ELLES ASSOCIATION

In 2020, support was initiated for women facing isolation by providing them with all necessary hygiene equipment.



PARTNERSHIP WITH PLANÈTE URGENCE

Between January 2018 and December 2020, JVD planted **over 48 000 trees**, in Indonesia and Cameroo.The concept? For every Air range hand dryer purchased, one tree is planted! Hand dryers are the best alternative to paper towel dispensers and an ideal solution for reducing ecological footprint. While the production and transportation of one ton of paper require 17 trees, they are also significant sources of CO2 emissions.



SOCIAL & HR

At JVD, we believe that inclusion and diversity are key drivers of organizational performance. From young professionals to seniors, and individuals with disabilities, the diversity of profiles within our company brings a wealth of ideas, perspectives, and experiences.



Health, well-being, and more broadly, the quality of life at work for its employees are considered by JVD as drivers of efficiency and sustainable performance. To achieve this, JVD has implemented or offers the following measures:

HEALTH AND SOCIAL PROTECTION

Healthcare expenses : The JVD health contract offers guarantees tailored to the new demands of its employees, such as alternative medicine (acupuncture, chiropractic, osteopathy...), psychology, and more. Furthermore, in the interest of fairness, JVD has chosen to align the compensation regime for non-managerial employees' sick leave with that of managers (which is more favorable).

Group insurance : Employees are exposed to multiple risks such as accidents, disabilities, and death. Group insurance helps protect them against these risks by providing compensation for their loss of income, both for themselves and their families. Additionally, it offers numerous services to support them during these challenging times.

Supplementary retirement benefits : For over 10 years, JVD has implemented this program for both non-managerial and managerial employees, aiming to supplement their retirement income and maintain their standard of living.





PROFIT SHARING

For more than 10 years, JVD has been implementing this program for both non-managerial and managerial employees, with the objective of augmenting their post-retirement income and preserving their standard of living.

INTEGRATION

The entire JVD team invests time and energy into the integration of its new employees. We support our employees from their first day. A mentor is assigned to ensure the smooth integration of each new collaborator. This step allows our new talents to more easily assimilate their tasks and the values of the company.



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TRANSMISSION

JVD regularly welcomes interns and trainees of all levels for an immersive experience ranging from a few days to several months within its establishment. These internships in the company serve as an initial contact with the professional world or as a career transition experience. Welcoming interns is an approach of openness and commitment that aligns perfectly with our CSR (Corporate Social Responsibility) initiative.
